Automatic Scholarships Renewed for Incoming Freshman

Kent State University at Trumbull has renewed campus scholarships for the 2019-2020 school year. Graduating high school seniors who apply and are admitted to Kent State University at Trumbull by May 1 and have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or greater, will automatically be awarded one of the following scholarships:

Kent State

Dean's Scholarship	\$4,000/year*	3.8 GPA
Gold Scholarship	\$2,000/year**	3.6 GPA
Silver Scholarship	\$1,500/year**	3.3 GPA
Bronze Scholarship	\$1,000/year**	3.0 GPA

* *Dean's Scholarship is renewable for four years. You must achieve a 3.0 GPA or higher and maintain continuous full-time enrollment at Kent State Trumbull.*

** *Gold, Silver & Bronze Scholarships may be renewed for an additional year if you achieve a 3.0 GPA or higher and earn 24 or more credit hours during your Freshman year.*

These scholarships can be combined with other privately funded and Honors scholarships. However, all require full-time enrollment at Kent State Trumbull for the 2019-2020 academic year (12 or more credit hours per semester). Yearly tuition at one of Kent State University's regional campuses is \$5,664.
