In accordance with the N.E.A. Master Contract, Article 6, Section 6.111: For all elementary/secondary regular education classroom teachers—"If special education IEP students are at least 25% of the overall population per class period and/or assignment, teachers will be compensated using the mathematical formula listed on the reverse side of this form, to determine the compensation per semester. Teachers who teach in a co-teaching classroom or have an inclusion teacher in their room will not be eligible for compensation for that class or period. Teachers will be compensated at the end of each semester. The teacher will be compensated if the IEP student is in class the <u>first five weeks of the student's enrollment per semester</u> regardless of movement. Upon agreement with the teacher, the building administrator shall be required to provide individual class roster documentation to the Superintendent."

Step I: Number of IEP students divided by the total number of students in class

Step II: Take number calculated by Step I and multiply by 100

Step III: Number calculated is percentage of IEP students in a class.

The percent of IEP students in class shall be rounded to the nearest whole number. The "rounding rule" of mathematics shall be used at all times. A digit in the tenths column of 5 or higher shall increase the digit in the ones column by an increment of one. For example, 6 IEP students in a class of 21 total students would result in step 2 calculation of .285 multiplied by 100, resulting in the step 3 calculation of 28.5%, which would then be rounded up to 29%.

Once the calculated percentage for compensation of IEP students is calculated, the following rates will be used for compensation to the teacher at the end of each semester:

Percentage of IEP Students

25% - 28% = \$50

29% -- 32% = \$100

33% -- 36% = \$150

37% -- 40% = \$200

41% -- 44% = \$250

45% -- 48% = \$300

49% -- 52% = \$350

53% -- 56% = \$400

57% -- 60% = \$450
