







































A Note to Families - After Reading

Encourage your child to read the book to you again. Most children love to reread books, and rereading makes them stronger readers.








Think of It like exercise

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Observational









Last week, we used shapes to spark our imaginations. This week, we will use the shapes to create something familiar. You will be creating an observational drawing of your favorite toy! **Observational** means that you need to **LOOK** at your object to find the shapes needed to draw it. Artists use observational drawings to help them practice and develop their skills. Remember when we drew the art supplies in the cup? That was an observational drawing (a still life). Here are the directions:

- 1. First, you will need to find your favorite toy and set it up in front of you so you can look at it while you draw.
- 2. Use the space on this paper, or get another paper and grab your pencil to get ready.
- 3. Now, look at your toy and try to see the shapes that make the toy. Is the top a circle? A triangle?
- **4.** Then, draw your toy with your pencil and color it in. Use any supplies that you have at home like pencils, crayons, or markers. If you do not have art supplies at home, use your regular pencil to make light and dark areas. Or, use the Drawing Pad app on your tablet to create your drawing. Don't forget to add a background!
