Now, 40 years beyond expansion, the time to return the stadium to "Ohio's Best" is now upon us.

Understandably, time, exposure to the elements, and advances in technology all make this the right time for Renovating Excellence In Niles.

The multi-year, multi-phase project is ambitious in both time and scope. Phase one—New lights, PA system and emergency structural repairs to the home and visitor stands—are complete.
